Course Description  
Design Size: 11/11 inches

This wondrous flower cluster incorporates the Jacobean style, Crewel Embroidery, Romanian Point Lace, Golden Coils and beads in a new form of expression. Students will experiment stitches as: Jacobean, Satin, French Knot, Fern, Alternate Satin, Coral, Pekin. Also will use golden coils and beads, DMC embroidery floss and DMC Cebelia threads. Romanian Point Lace will be a large part of this design, which includes: crocheted cord and fancy needle lace stitches as: Feather, Net, Wheat Ear. After completing this course students will be able to work any other Romanian Point Lace project.

There is an optional colour choice of white or off white.

Class Goals

Students will learn basic Romanian Point Lace technique, history and traditional and modern practical uses of it. They will also learn stitches as: Raspberry, Woven Net, Buttonhole, Russian, Knotted Russian, Feather and embroidery stitches as: Stem/Outline, Chain, Satin, French Knot and other. Students will learn to crochet the cord.
